The City of Hope Department of Clinical Cancer Genetics *Cancer Genetics Education Program* is **now accepting applications** for its annual intensive interdisciplinary training course in cancer risk assessment.

The course combines traditional and distance learning methods to address the needs of working clinicians, while providing interdisciplinary training, clinical support and research networking. Open to oncology or genetics-trained physicians, advanced practice nurses and genetic counselors currently providing or planning to initiate community-based clinical cancer genetics services.

Web-Conference Orientation - Friday, January 9, 2009

Phase 1 - Distance Learning Modules with weekly Web Conference discussion sessions

January 9 to March 6, 2009 (8 weeks)

Phase 2 - Interactive cancer genetics workshops on the City of Hope campus

March 9 to 13, 2009 (5 Days)

Phase 3 - Continued post-course learning, clinical and research support via Web Board and Web

Conferencing activities (One Year)

Extended Application Deadline: October 31, 2008

The course is supported by funding from the National Cancer Institute (Grant 1R25 CA112486). Participants will be provided shared housing and a travel stipend of \$200. Participants (or their institutions) are responsible for a \$310 non-refundable fee to cover amenities and materials not covered by grant support.

City of Hope National Medical Center designates this education activity for a maximum of 70 hours of Category 1 credit toward the AMA Physician's Recognition Award, and 7.35 CEUs through the American Counseling Association for genetic counselors.
